

ORDINANCE NO. 32

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 29
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Goshen adopted Ordinance 29 on February 11, 2003 and thereby created a moratorium on the approval of subdivision plats, large scale development or lot splits within the corporate limits and planning area of the City of Goshen for a period of sixty-five (65) days; and

WHEREAS, the conditions which existed at the time of the passage of Ordinance 29 on February 11, 2003 remain largely unchanged, but the time of moratorium is about to expire.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF GOSHEN, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance 29 is amended as follows: "one hundred twenty (120) days" shall be substituted wherever "sixty-five (65) days" appears. The intended effect of this ordinance is to extend the moratorium created by Ordinance 29. In all other respects, Ordinance 29 is ratified and reaffirmed.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE: It is hereby declared that based on the conditions set forth herein, an emergency exists and this Ordinance, being necessary for the immediate protection of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Goshen, Arkansas, shall be in effect immediately upon its passage, approval, and publication.
